

MEN'S D LABOR DAY INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT September 2-3, 2006-4 game guarantee

4 game guarantee with 2 pool play games and then a double elimination Welcome to the ASA Men's Class D Labor Day Invitational Slow Pitch Tournament to be held in Kansas City over Labor Day weekend starting Saturday September 3 thru Sunday September 4, 2005. Monday September 5th will only be used in case of inclement weather. **There will be no managers meeting.** We will post the schedule for the pool play on Thursday August 30th, 2006. The pool games will seed into the double elimination bracket.

Blue Valley Recreation Softball Complex is one of the finest facilities in the United States. It has eight 300' fenced fields, seven batting cages, and is in its 26th year of operation. This is the 21st year of this event and it has been one of the most successful events of its kind with teams participating in the 2005 event from 7 different states.

<u>Home Run Rule:</u> The current 2006 ASA home run rule will apply. No home runs in Men's D are allowed. The first batter hitting a home run will be ruled an out. All other home runs hit after this will be ruled an out and no disqualifiction will be envoked.

Trophies: Team trophies for 1st-3rd place. Individual awards for 1st and 2nd place. (12 per team).

<u>Tournament Softballs</u>: <u>Teams will hit the softballs they furnish</u>. Balls must be ASA approved-COR .44-375 compression. Each team will receive 2 Worth Blue Dots at the manager's meeting.

<u>Umpires:</u> One umpire for all pool games. Two umpires for all double elimination games.

Uniforms: Uniforms tops must be matching and have at least 6" numbers on the back as set out in the ASA code. No longer required that shorts/pants match for this event but are highly suggested.

They are still required at all ASA National Championships. This is a NIT and your team needs to look the part.

Bats: Please check the ASA National website at www.softball.org for a current listing of approved bats.

ASA Stealing rule will not be used for this event.Deadline for Registration is Monday August 28, 2006

There will be a gate charge of \$2.00 per day for everyone including players. You will receive a token redeemable for \$1.00 in product at the concession stands.

ENTRY FEE - \$275 (CASHIER'S CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY)

Prize Fund-\$75 per team will be put into a pool and distributed equally to the top 3 teams in the tournament as a cash prize.
